Saints and Sinners

What is a saint?

Someone who is perfect, someone who did something great, someone who must be way "holier" than us.

Some traditions have specific definitions for sainthood. In the Catholic Church, a saint has to have caused two miracles and be beyond repute. For us protestants we, as in most things, have a squishier definition. We often think of saints around November 1, when we celebrate as All Saints Day. On the Sunday nearest, we often remember those that have gone on to glory, the "saints of the church" that have made us who we are. We also sometimes think of saints as laudable people. John Wesley, Martin Luther King Jr., or other exemplary Christians. Thinking about who is a saint and why they are is important. Saints provide us with an example to live by. They were real people living in the real world who somehow found a way to live an extraordinary life. They preached the faith, healed the sick, brought thousands to know Christ, and sometimes died for their efforts. In their work and piety and life, we can find heroes to emulate.

But sometimes thinking about these heroes can have a down side. We sometimes put them on too high of a pedestal, so high that we need not follow their example. After all, they were superheroes, and we are mere mortals. Of course we can't do what they did. We can let ourselves off the hook by putting ourselves in the category of "ordinary Christian" and let the saints do the real work

During November, we are going to take a look at saints, both in our life and the life of the church. There are some notable people that did amazing things for our faith and for the world. It's good to see what we can learn from them. But it's also important to know that they weren't perfect. They all had flaws, just like us. They all struggled, just like us. And none of them probably thought of themselves as saints, just like us.

So think about who made an impact in your life. Who showed you what it means to be a Christian? Who helped you develop your faith? Who laid the foundations, figuratively or literally, for our church? What about these people are we able to emulate? Peace,
