# **New Beginnings**

I've been thinking about change lately. Two months ago, you and I experienced a change when I began serving here as pastor. Changes are things that happen once. There is a definite juncture; one day I was not your pastor and the next day I was. We experience changes all the time. Some are small: the change of one TV show to another, the change of seasons. Other changes are big and less regular: the start of a school, the beginning or ending of a relationship.

We many times don't like change. We like the status quo: we as humans do a great job of getting used to the way things are. When things change, it upsets our systems, it increases our anxiety. Even when changes are good, there can still be anxiety. The change of entering into marriage is one of the most joyous times in a person's life. Yet a bride and groom in the moments before the wedding are often the most anxious people in the world. That's because the effects of change continue well beyond the actual change. A wedding is a relatively short event; a marriage will hopefully last a long time. A change of job happens once, but the implications last a long time. Business gurus have a name for these knock-on effects: Transitions. Transitions start well before a change and last well after a change. Transitions involve all of the emotions that we experience around a change: the fear about the unknown, the excitement for something new, the anxiety about what might happen, the hope in a new future.

The problem is, we often focus on the change, and give short shrift to transitions. We don't always prepare for change or how we will feel after a change happens. This can make change all the

harder. If we don't attend to transitions, it can make the process of change all the more difficult. In September, we are going to begin a sermon series on transitions. This is a good time to think about the emotions we feel around change. We have been transitioning into new pastoral leadership. Many are transitioning into a new school year. And we have all of the other transitions that happen in life. Attending to transitions helps us as individuals and us as a church successfully live into a new reality. In October, we are going to transition (see what I did there?) into a commitment series. We'll be looking at the membership vows of the United Methodist Church, and how we might recommit to following them in our lives. We'll have the opportunity to make a pledge on how we will live into these vows for the coming year. I pray God's blessing on us as we continue to transition into a new reality.
