Grace to you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

My name is Andrew Phillips, and starting July 1, I have the privilege of serving as pastor of Hopkins and South Monterey UMCs.

I've been meditating on the first chapter of Romans as I have been preparing to come to you. Paul writes to the saints in Rome that "I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed throughout the world." Our world is a lot bigger than Paul's world, so while Hopkins and South Monterey might not be known in all the world, your faith is proclaimed throughout Allegan County and the Michigan Conference of the UMC. The way this church community takes a leading role in feeding the hungry through the Food Pantry and Meals on Wheels is a living witness to Jesus Christ, the Bread of Life. And the generosity of this community in contributing to the ministry of the whole UMC testifies to Jesus who took the five loaves and two fish of a small boy, and multiplied them to feed thousands. It is for this kind of faith that I give thanks to God whenever I think of you.



We enjoy life with our dog Jed (who can't wait to meet you!), going to the Farmer's Market, and spending time outside and with friends.

WE HAVE A LICENSED KITCHEN

Good news! We are officially approved to operate with a permanent food license!

There is some cleaning and organizing that needs to happen in the storage areas. Mainly unused items need to be discarded and we need better organization.

Casseroles for the bazaar can be made in home kitchens and brought to the church thirty days prior to the bazaar and stored together in a designated freezer.

We can continue to use the dishwasher but it needs to be set to the longest wash cycle and heated dry.

We will have some meetings soon to go over all the changes that we all should be aware of.

Thanks to everyone that helped with this process! I'm happy it's over, Now we just need to continue to follow the guidelines in place.

If you or anyone has questions or concerns about some of the new guidelines, just ask Darcie, Alaina or me. We are all official certified food managers. We'd be happy to answer questions or go over the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) approved by the health department.
