Summer Worship Plan

The following is based on the discussion by the Ad-Board at the 7/13 meeting. We decided on the following good weather and bad weather plans for worship:

Good Weather Plan	Bad Weather Plan
10am – Worship at Common Ground 6:30pm – Zoom Fellowship 7pm – Zoom Worship	10am – Zoom Worship for everyone After service – Fellowship time

In good weather, we will have 2 services, one at 10am at Common Ground, and one at 7pm on Zoom. With Zoom Fellowship at 6:30pm.

We feel that it is safe to have in-person worship outside as things stand right now with the virus if we maintain social distance and wear masks. If we can continue outside safely, we hope to do this until the weather turns in the Fall.

To include and connect with those that we could be excluding by choosing to have morning worship in-person, Pastor Kelsey will be leading the online service on Zoom.

In the case of bad weather, we will have one worship all together on Zoom at 10am. At present, we do not feel as if we have the resources and staff availability to make it smart and safe to worship inside. In this case, the hope is that we can make the call early enough to mail bulletins to everyone. Keep alert for a last minute call though. Let us know if you need to be added to the phone tree, as you do not receive the internet-based communications.

We will be revisiting this decision at our monthly Ad-Board meetings (or sooner if there is a drastic change with the virus).
